Entry Rules

- This competition is open to all swimmers currently registered with Swimming Canada or a World Aquatics affiliated club.
- Each swimmer is allowed a maximum of three (3) events per session
- Each swimmer is allowed a maximum of 10 TOTAL events
- A minimum of 40 and maximum of 250 swimmers will be registered for this meet.
- To ensure the highest quality meet, the meet manager reserves the right to limit the number of swimmers and/or the number of individual swims due to time constraints.
- NT (no time) entries will not be accepted; please use a coach estimated time if necessary.
- Swimmer age is determined as of Saturday, February 10, 2024
- All entries must be submitted through the Swimming Canada online system.
- Deck entries will be EXHIBITION only and accepted only if the swimmer is already entered in the meet and the entry does not create a new heat.
- Entry fees are \$10.00 per individual event
- Entry Fees are non-refundable after the scratch deadline.

- The Swim Alberta Scratch Rule will be in effect for this meet.

Age Groups

• Male and Female: 10 & Under, 11-12, 13-14, 15 & Over

Awards

 Individual: 1st- 6th place ribbons will be awarded for each event by age group and gender.

Meet Format/Rules

- The meet will be conducted under published World Aquatics and/or World Para Swimming rules and regulations supplemented by published and approved Swimming Canada and Swim Alberta rules and regulations. In addition, this meet package shall outline all changes to and specific application of the published rules. Swim Alberta policies and procedures, where appropriate will also apply.
- Swimming Canada competition warm-up safety procedures will be in effect at this meet
- Entry to competition is limited to participants who have passed Swim Alberta's Competition Swim Test. During competition, swimmers should dive at the Dive Readiness Progression skill level they have achieved.
- Starts will be conducted from Starting Platforms (blocks) as per World Aquatics rules FR 2.3, FR 2.7 and SW 4.1.
- All events are timed finals
- Coaches must submit estimated entry times in lieu of no-time (NT) entries.
- Events will be swum slowest to fastest with separate gender and mixed ages (with exception to the 400 IM, 400m freestyle, 800m freestyle & 1500m freestyle).
- The 400IM, 400m freestyle, 800m freestyle & 1500m freestyle will be swum with the fastest to slowest. The 400 IM, 400m freestyle, 800m freestyle & 1500m freestyle MAY be swum mixed genders.
- The Meet Manager reserves the option to cancel and/or alter events as necessary to meet time constraints.

Safe Sport

• All interactions between an athlete and an individual who is in a position of trust should normally, and wherever possible, be in an environment or space that is both "open" and "observable" to others.

Swimwear at Competitions

All swimmers are permitted to race with the swimwear of their choosing at all competitions sanctioned by Swim Alberta. It is not required to declare the choice of swimwear to the referee if the fabric of the swimwear is a permeable open mesh textile and would not reasonably be seen to create a technical advantage in terms of speed, buoyancy or endurance.
