Entry Information

Entry Deadline: Monday, May 11, 2026

Scratch Deadline: Friday, May 22, 2026

Minimum entries: 100

Maximum entries: 425

Reserved entries: 90

Swimmers may enter one (1) event on Friday night and two (2) events per session on Saturday and Sunday with a maximum of eight (8) events total for the meet. 400 freestyle, 400 individual medley and 800 freestyle events will be swum as mixed gender events. Meet Management reserves the right to limit entries in any event or session to control session length. Meet Management may accept additional swims beyond the stated limit where space permits.

Entry Fees

\$17.00 per race

Team fees can be paid at the Meet Manager's Office.

Entry Process

All entries must be submitted through the Swim Canada online system (REMS).

Deck entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Meet Manager where space permits. Deck entries will be charged double the entry fee.

Seeding

All events will be senior seeded, Friday's events will be swum fastest to slowest, Saturday and Sunday will be slowest to fastest.

Age Categories

10&U, 11-12, 13-14, 15&O

Eligibility

This competition is open to swimmers currently registered with Swim Canada or a World Aquatics affiliated club. **NO TIME entries will not be accepted.** Entries containing no time will not be accepted by Swim Canada's online system.

Competition and Diving Readiness Standards

Entry to competition is limited to participants who have passed Swim Alberta's Competition Swim Test. During competition, swimmers should dive at the Dive Readiness Progression skill level they have achieved. Backstroke ledges will be used at this meet.

Warm up Procedures

Swim Canada competition warm-up safety procedures will be in effect at this meet.

Safe Sport

All interactions between an athlete and an individual who is in a position of trust should normally, and wherever possible, be in an environment or space that is both “open” and “observable” to others.

Rules

The meet will be conducted under published World Aquatics and/or World Para Swimming rules and regulations supplemented by published and approved Swimming Canada and Swim Alberta rules and regulations. In addition, this meet package shall outline all changes to and specific application of the published rules. Swim Alberta policies and procedures, where appropriate will also apply.

Diving Rules

Starts will be conducted from Starting Platforms (blocks) as per World Aquatics Facility Rule 16.1.4, 16.1.8 and Swimming Canada’s Swimming Rule 4.1.

Scratches

The Swim Alberta scratch rule will be in effect for this competition. Scratches made after the deadline will not be refunded.

Results

Heat sheets and unofficial results will be uploaded to Meet Mobile. Official results will be sent to Swim Canada at the end of the meet on Monday, June 1, 2026.

Awards

Ribbons will be awarded to the top 10 swimmers in each age category for each event. Prizes will be awarded for swimmers who achieve a personal best time in their event.

Marshalling

There will be **NO** marshalling at this meet.

Officials

We would like to invite anyone that is able to volunteer to officiate and take advantage of the SilverRays hospitality. Please submit your request to officiate, stating desired positions and sessions to: officials@silverrays.ca Clubs entered in the 400m freestyle, 400m individual medley or 800m Freestyle must supply officials to participate in the event. Meet Management reserves the right to scratch, without refund, swimmers from those events if this condition is not met.

Swimwear at Competitions

All swimmers are permitted to race with the swimwear of their choosing at all competitions sanctioned by Swim Alberta. It is not required to declare the choice of swimwear to the Referee if the fabric of the swimwear is a permeable open mesh textile and would not reasonably be seen to create a technical advantage in terms of speed, buoyancy, or endurance.

Requirement for Time Trial Sanctions

A Time Trial sanction is intended for a record attempt and is limited to one (1) event with one (1) swimmer. No entry fees are permitted for Time Trials.

Photography/Videography

In order to minimize risk, all photographs and video taken at Swimming Canada/PSO sanctioned competitions, whether taken by a professional photographer or videographer, spectator, team support staff or any other participant, must observe generally accepted standards of decency. Under no circumstances are cameras or other recording devices allowed in the area immediately behind the starting blocks during practice or competition starts, or in locker rooms, bathrooms, or any other dressing area.
